

# To all families with children who use the Toledo Pool

Children who cannot swim and are under 48" tall must be accompanied in the water by a supervisor when using the pool.

A supervisor must be at least 14 years of age and stay within an arms reach of the child. A supervisor may supervise no more than two non-swimming children under 48" tall.



**Non-Swimmers regardless of age, cannot be in the deep end of the pool except during City Led Instructional Programs**

What is a “Good Enough” Swimmer

Why the Rule Changes?

-Swimming a steady crawl stroke, 70 feet (2 widths of the pool) without stopping, touching the bottom, showing comfortable breathing and a horizontal body position

-This rule will help ensure there are more layers of protection to keep kids safe. As a staff we looked all our rules and felt this was a needed step.
