Elections Officer Accepting Candidate Filings for 2018 Election Deadline to submit candidacy filing is August 28, 2018

The positions of Mayor and three Councilors will appear on the November 6, 2018 General Election ballot. Individuals interested in serving on the Toledo City Council may file for candidacy. **The filing period for interested candidates is open and the filing process, including signature verification, must be completed by 5:00 p.m., August 28, 2018.**

A person may File by Fee or File by Petition with the City of Toledo Elections Officer. To file by fee, a person must file a declaration of candidacy form, the **SEL Form 101 – Mayor Political Party or Nonpartisan**, and pay the \$10 filing fee.

To File by Petition a person must complete and submit two forms with the City Elections Officer **prior to gathering any signatures** and well in advance of the August 28 deadline. No filing fees are required to run for the City of Toledo offices by this method. Candidates are encouraged to meet with the City Elections Officer to review the filing process.
