To begin, I am writing this message on the one month anniversary of my arrival here at Toledo City Hall! It has been a great month. I have enjoyed getting to know the Council, staff, and citizens during this introductory period and look forward to working with all of you over the coming years.

A group of citizens, the Toledo Artists Guild, has proposed placing a "Little Free Library" somewhere within the city— preferably in front of City Hall. Due to concerns about

the issues such placement may cause with maintaining the grass and other landscaping in front of our building, we have worked with them to find a more suitable place. A spot near the deck across the street appears to be amenable to both parties. The structure, which resembles a large birdhouse, will be decorated by the Guild and maintained by them as well. I am happy to have the City be a part of a community partnership to bring something positive to Main Street.

What's Happening In Toledo?

Siletz Water Intake

The structure is nearing completion. The next phase of this project is the pump housing install at the very top of the landing.

HWY 20 Water Main Replacement

This project is moving on schedule along Business 20, with the next significant activity being a tie-in at Sturdevant, near the High School.

Olalla Crossing

The Pre-Construction meeting has been held and ground breaking on this project is estimated to commence on 10/15/14. The bid for the project was awarded to RNG General Contractors. Scope of work is to install

3000+ LF of 18" HDPE to convey raw water to our WTP.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

The Toledo Fire Department is midway through their Firefighter I Academy. The class includes volunteer recruits from Newport, Seal Rock and Toledo.

In January the Department will host the Emergency Management Response Course.

Other projects include disaster preparedness classes held at Ed-dyville Charter School.
