The Toledo Municipal Swimming Pool has openings for its Lifeguard position. This position requires the ability to work successfully with the public of all ages and abilities, ensuring the safety for all patrons of the facility.

Applicants must be at least 16 years of age. A current American Red Cross Lifeguarding Certificate or the ability to obtain certification within thirty days of hire is required. Beginning pay is \$10.21 per hour. Work schedule: sixteen to nineteen hours per week, evenings and weekends only. Recruitment is open until filled.
